THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE ACCESSING A COE

If you have questions, please call Customer Service at 800-863-7515

- Members must be pre-approved to use a designated COE facility or practitioner.
- Designated COE providers may be located out of Prominence Health Plan's primary service area, members may be eligible for travel benefits of up to \$3,000 per trip* total.
- If a COE facility is unable to provide the required services, a non-COE facility may be pre-approved by Prominence Health Plan's Utilization Management team.

^{*} Includes lodging/meals at \$200 per day, up to a maximum of \$2,000 per trip. Airfare/rental car or personal vehicle mileage at \$1,000 maximum per trip. \$10,000 annual limit on all eligible travel expenses.
