Talks of creating a way to properly accept tax eligible donations to support IAFF Local 3895's community outreach efforts began in late 2012. Unfortunately, the impetus did not kick into high gear until after the injury of one of our own. As reality set in following Captain Bill Winchester's career-ending accident, Local 3895's executive board worked to organize the influx of support and began taking steps to create a non-profit charitable organization. In December 2014, the Truckee Meadows Firefighter Foundation, INC. was established. Since then, the foundation board has adopted a mission statement:

"The TM Firefighter Foundation is a 501c3 non-profit charitable organization formed to promote a greater quality of life by assisting the community, its members, and their families during times of serious illness, injury, or loss through financial and humanitarian aid."

In sum, we are focused on the principle of helping others in times of need. Whether it is first responders helping civilians or first responders helping first responders and their families, the TM Firefighter Foundation will provide support and charitable outreach to the greatest extent possible. The foundation recognizes that people helping people in time of need is sometimes the strongest resource to provide.

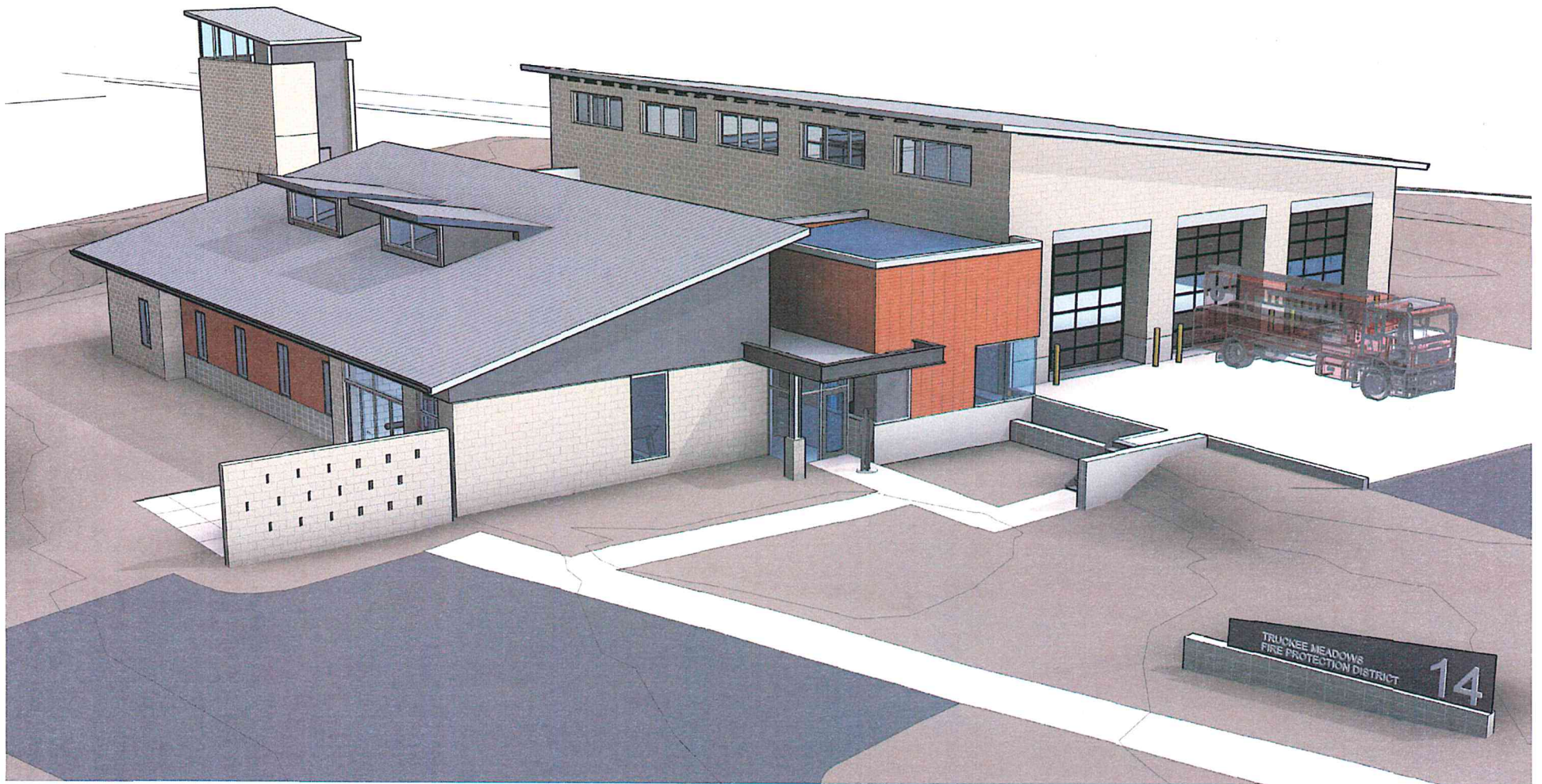

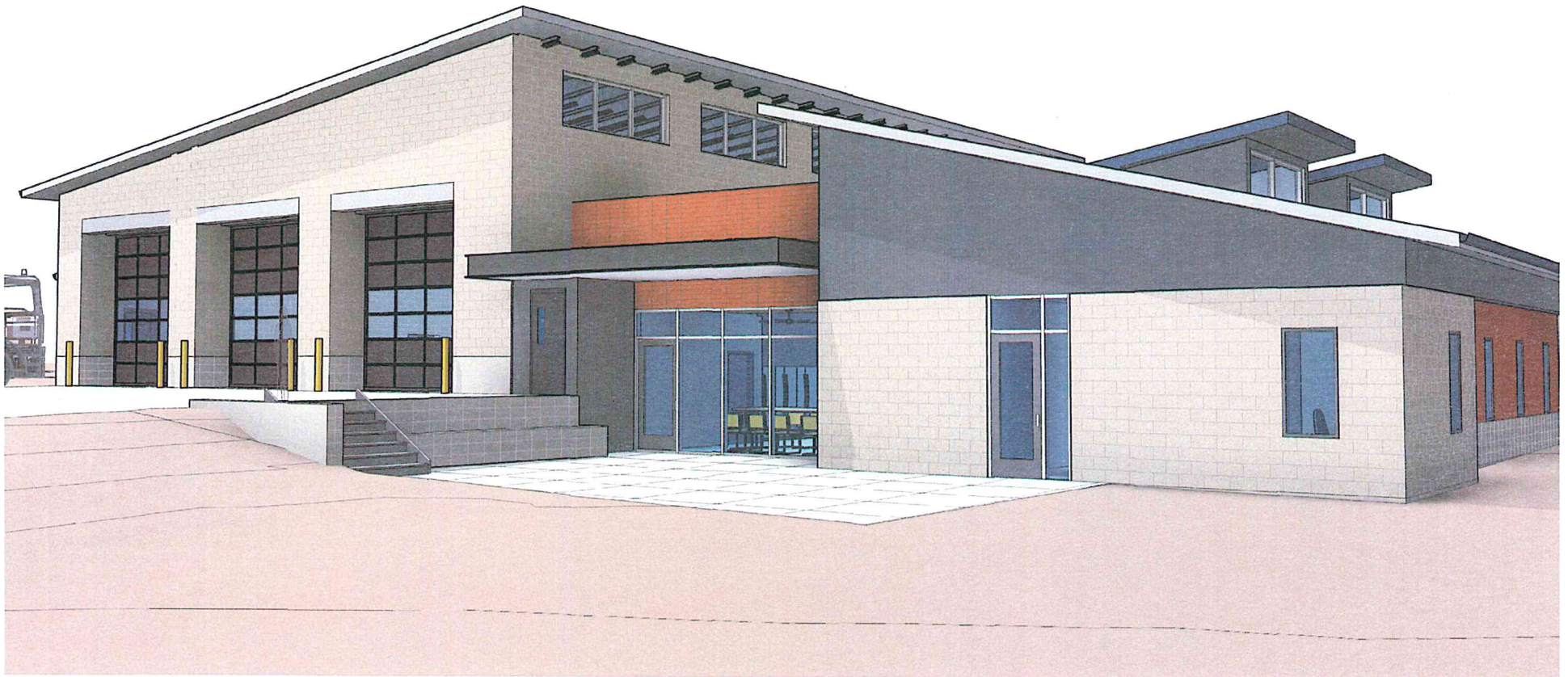
