

The following tables show all reported TMFPD EMS-related calls including 300 series, 554, and 611E incident types, that matched to REMSA during calendar year 2017 by priority and station. All calls were utilized for analysis, including calls where either TMFPD or REMSA was cancelled en route.

The first table shows the number of calls, while the second table shows the breakdown of call priorities as a percentage of the total calls per station.
