The Board convened at 9:00 a.m. in regular session in the Commission Chambers of the Washoe County Administration Complex, 1001 East Ninth Street, Reno, Nevada. Following the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag of our Country, the Clerk called the roll and the Board conducted the following business:

# 19-127F AGENDA ITEM 3 Public Comment.

There was no response to the call for public comment.

# **19-128F** AGENDA ITEM 4 Announcements/Reports.

Truckee Meadows' Fire Protection District Chief Charles Moore announced the Long Valley Fire was fully contained. He thanked regional and federal partners who assisted in suppressing the fire. He said severe fire weather was anticipated for the following two days. Dry lightning could affect the area on August 28 and there was a risk of fires rekindling on August 29 if trees or brush were struck.

Commissioner Herman reported local resident Mr. Garth Elliot passed away the prior day and said he would be missed. She thanked firefighters for their work throughout the season. She commended them for their efforts on the Long Valley Fire.

Chair Hartung thanked the firefighters who battled the Long Valley Fire. He noted the fire took off rapidly. He looked forward to learning about the investigation of the cause, the number of acres affected, and the total amount of loss.

- **19-129F** <u>5A</u> Recommendation to approve the minutes from the July 16, 2019 Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District's Board of Fire Commissioners meeting. (All Commissioners Districts.)
- **19-130F <u>5B</u>** Recommendation to approve a Cooperative Equipment & Operating Agreement between Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District and the State of Nevada acting by and through the Nevada Division of Forestry Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (NDF) to include NDF furnishing the District with Equipment relating to a Dozer Program to assist with Fire Suppression efforts; if approved this will result in NDF providing the District with a dozer, tractor truck and trailer, which the District will be responsible for insuring and maintaining. - **19-131F** <u>5C</u> Recommendation to unfreeze and approve the re-classification of one (1) frozen Program Assistant position to a District Support Specialist position at an annual salary range of \$46,072 to \$60,000 to provide specified administrative services to the District. (All Commission Districts.)

On motion by Commissioner Berkbigler, seconded by Commissioner Herman, which motion duly carried on a 5-0 vote, it was ordered that Consent Agenda Items 5A through 5C be approved.

**19-132F** <u>AGENDA LTEM 6</u> Recommendation to approve a retroactive collective bargaining agreement between the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District and the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District Firefighters Association, IAFF Local 2487 Non-Supervisory Unit for a three year term effective July 1, 2019, and if approved authorize the Chair to sign on behalf of the Board. (All Commission Districts.)

Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District Chief Charles Moore said the agreement was for employees with ranks of Captain or below. He explained the contract was for a 3-year term and included cost of living increases, education incentives for staff, and additional post-employment benefits. He said it included specialty pay for HAZMAT and water entry team personnel and noted the contract had been ratified by the union.

Chair Hartung thanked Chief Moore and the negotiating team for negotiating a 3-year contract because it allowed District business to move forward instead of being in constant negotiations.

There was no public comment on this item.

On motion by Commissioner Jung, seconded by Commissioner Berkbigler, which motion duly carried on a 5-0 vote, it was ordered that Agenda Item 6 be approved and authorized.

**19-133F** <u>AGENDA ITEM 7</u> Recommendation to approve a retroactive collective bargaining agreement between the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District and the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District Firefighters Association, IAFF Local 2487 Supervisory Unit for a three year term effective July 1, 2019, and if approved authorize the Chair to sign on behalf of the Board. (All Commission Districts.)

Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District Chief Charles Moore said this unit was comprised of battalion chiefs, division chiefs, one logistics chief, and one fleet manager for a total of ten people. He said the terms were approximately the same as the non-supervisory agreement so staff recommended approval.
