01-30F <u>BUDGET – TRUCKEE MEADOWS FIRE PROTECTION</u> DISTRICT - FISCAL YEAR 2001/2002

<u>10:30 a.m.</u> This was the time set in a Notice of Public Hearing published in the Reno Gazette-Journal on May 11, 2001 to provide for public comment in the consideration of the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District Tentative Budget for Fiscal Year 2001/2002, as well as possible adoption of the Final Budget. Proof was made that due and legal Notice had been given.

Marty Scheuerman, Operations Chief, Reno Fire Department, reviewed the 2001/2002 final budget. He advised there was a slight change from the tentative budget presented to the Board last month, being that, through the diligent work of their consultant, Mary Walker, Walker and Associates, and Ray Sibley, Washoe County Risk Manager, the District was able to reflect \$123,726 in savings for insurance costs. This eliminated the \$40,000 operating deficit, and, based on the five-year projection and a modest 3% growth rate, the District is looking at being solvent for the next five years, as long as there is no downturn in the economy. He noted that no increase is being requested in the District's property tax rate.

Upon inquiry of Commissioner Galloway, Ms. Walker advised that the budget assumes a 5% increase per year for contracted services the District pays to the City of Reno. Mr. Scheuerman responded to questions of Commissioner Short.

Chairman Shaw opened the public hearing and called on those wishing to speak. There being no response, the public hearing was closed.

On motion by Commissioner Galloway, seconded by Commissioner Short, which motion duly carried, Chairman Shaw ordered that the final budget of the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District for fiscal year 2001/2002 be adopted. It was further ordered that submission to the Department of Taxation be authorized following execution by all members of the Board.

Chairman Shaw noted that Commissioner Bond was not present today as she is attending the National Association of Counties (NACO) conference.

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There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting adjourned.
