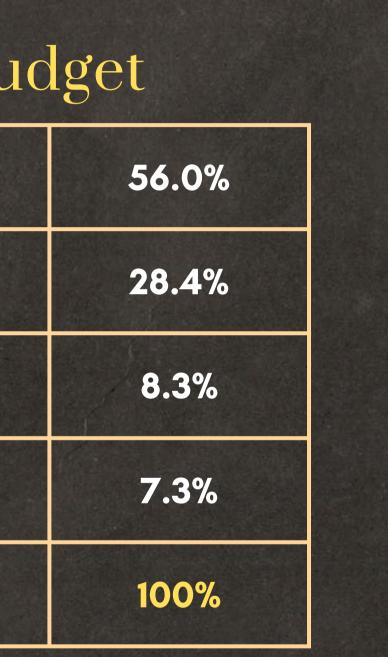

- Washoe Valley Consolidated Station and Apple. Construction planned to start FY23.
- Vehicles delivery of FY22 approved purchases.

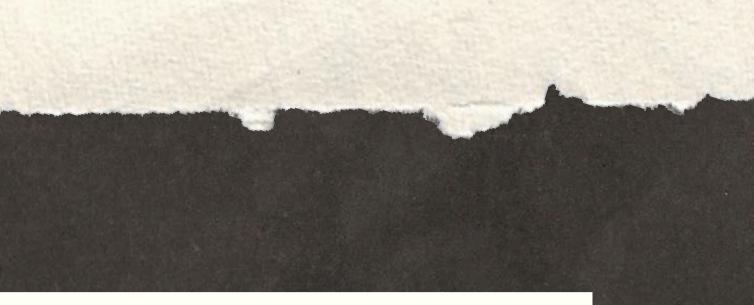


Capital Projects

Bond Financed Projects: \$10,000,000

In order of priority:

- 1. Washoe Valley Consolidated Station \$7.5M.
- 2. Barron Way Improvements. This projects improves efficiency for fleet maintenance, increased site security, and adds training components.) \$1.5M
- 3. Apple Station (additional 2 crew quarters) \$250k
- 4. Balance for design and development fees. \$750k

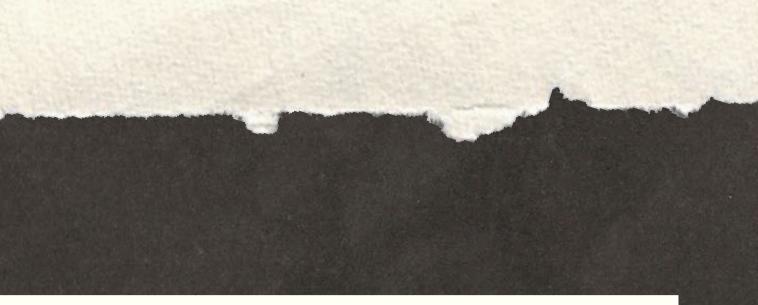






Other Funds

- Emergency Medical Services new proprietary fund.
- Emergency Fire Fund self replenishing
- Sick, Annual and Comp Benefits Fund. Transfer \$250,000
- Debt Service Fund. Principal and Interest of \$1,004,060
- Stabilization Fund. Fund balance of \$642,067
- Workers Compensation Fund City of Reno Heart & Lung claims
