## Events/Incidents of Interest



### Sun Valley Structure Fire with Fatality

TMFR crews responded to an early morning fire in Sun Valley at Chocolate Drive and Loster Way. Upon arrival, a double wide was fully involved with heavy smoke. Crews executed a quick knock down. Unfortunately, the blaze did result in a single fatality.



### Spanish Springs backyard fire

On June 3, TMFR Crews knocked down a structure fire confined to a shed on De Wick Court off of Calle De La Platta.

Damage was confined to a chicken coup, a small tractor, and a shed. No damage to the main residential structure or adjoining garden. The fire originated in the tractor and spread to a diesel canister that exploded causing the blaze.



### Tractor Trailer with Cattle Response

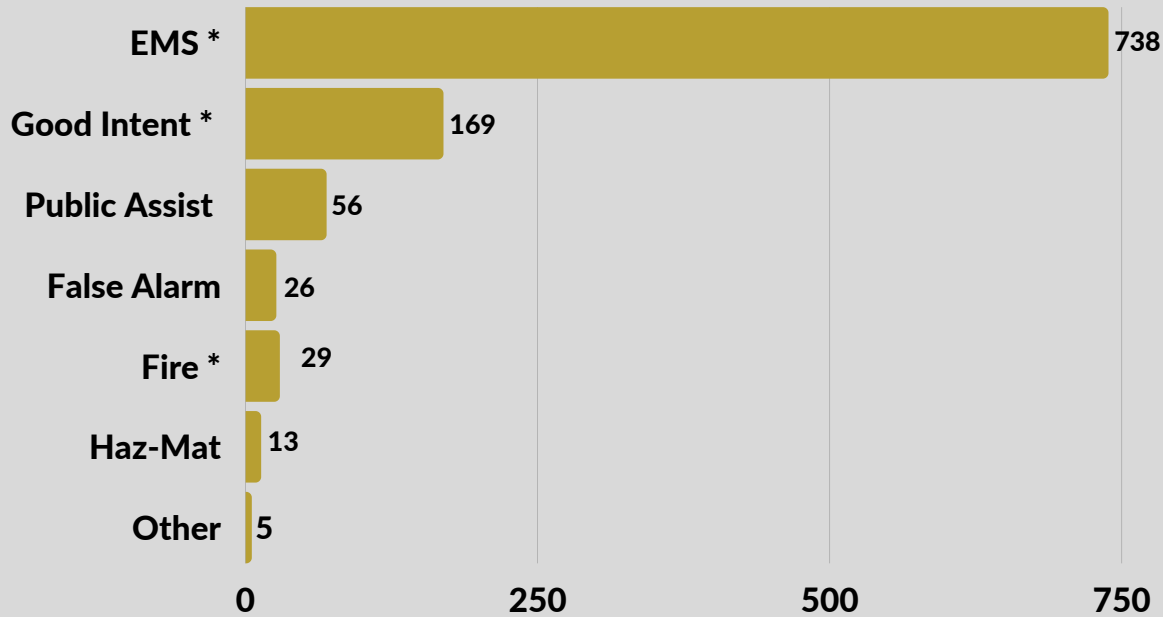
On June 18, TMFR Crews responded to a tractor trailer full of cattle, that had gone off the freeway near USA Parkway as a result of another vehicle. Crews worked with state agencies to recover the trailer and cattle. The Interstate was closed for several hours. No reported injuries to drivers. Some cattle did not survive the incident.



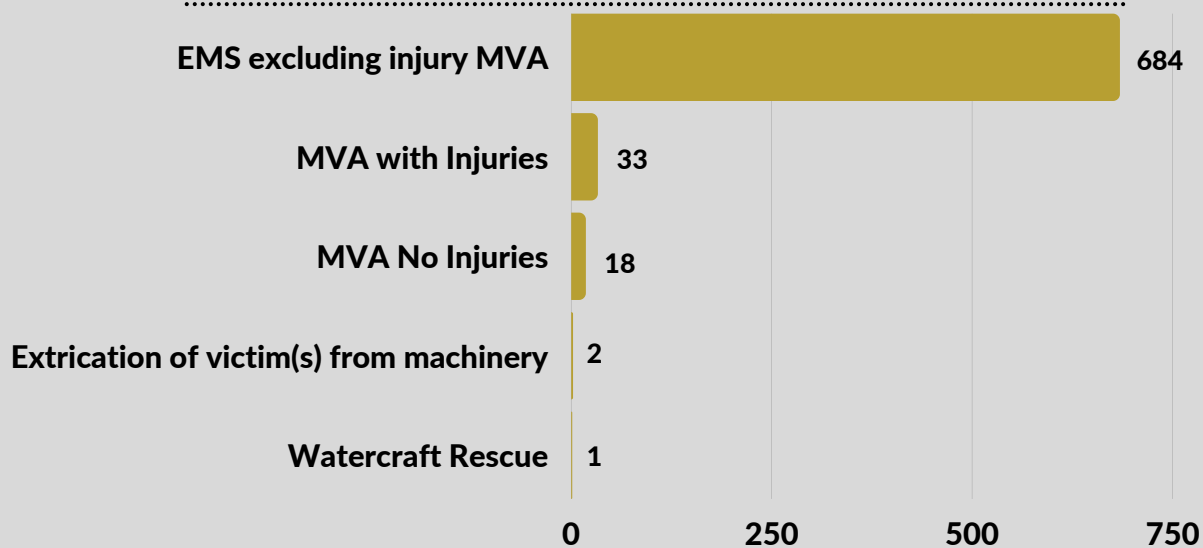

**Incident Total for June 2022: 1,036**



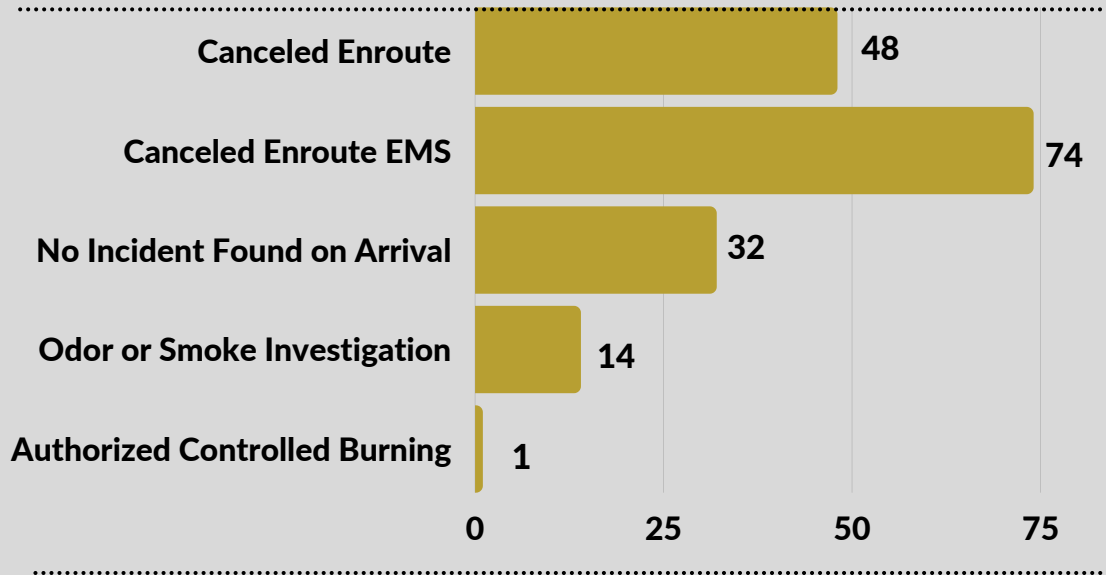

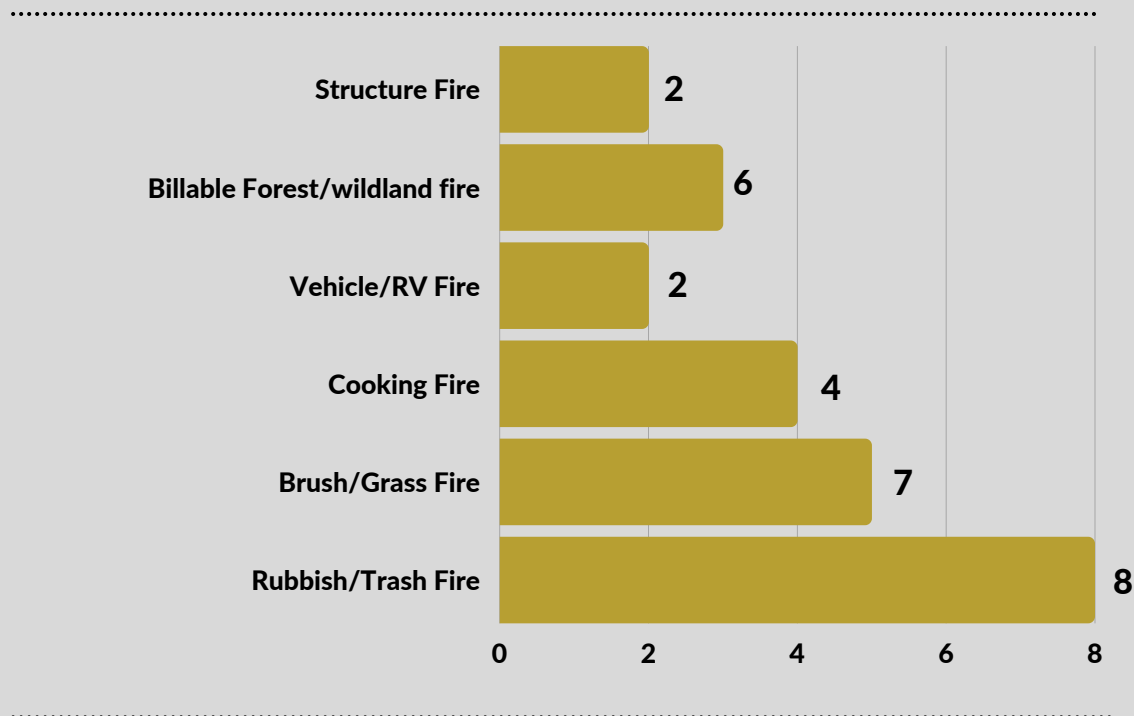

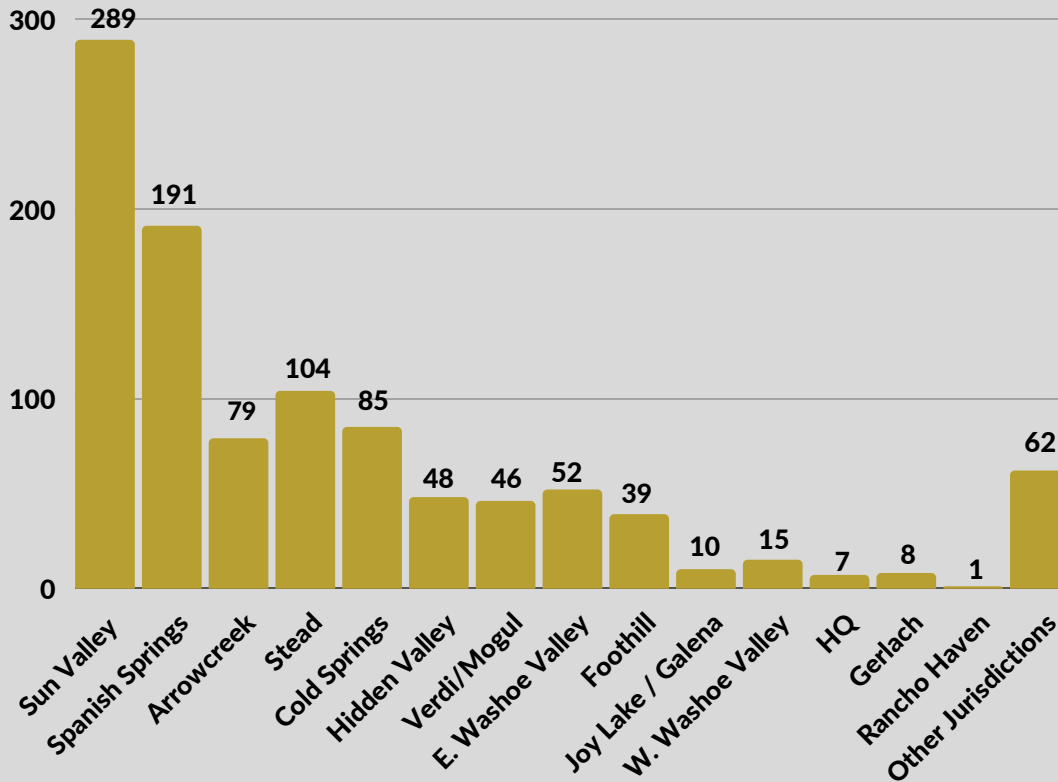
