NOTE: Items on the agenda may be taken out of order; combined with other items; removed from the agenda; moved to the agenda of another meeting; moved to or from the Consent section; or may be voted on in a block. Items with a specific time designation will not be heard prior to the stated time but may be heard later. The Consent section is a single agenda item and is considered as a block and will not be read aloud.

Accessibility. In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, the Washoe County Commission Chambers are accessible and those requiring accommodation for this meeting should notify the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District at (775) 326-6000, at least two business days prior to the meeting.

Public Comment. Public comments are welcomed during the Public Comment periods at the beginning and end of the meeting on any matter, whether listed on the agenda or not, and are limited to three minutes per person per comment period. Additionally, public comment will be heard during individually numbered items designated as "for possible action" on the agenda; is limited to three minutes per person per comment period; and should pertain to the specific item(s) being considered by the commission. Persons are invited to submit comments in writing on the agenda items by emailing publiccomment@tmfpd.us and/or attend and make comment on that item at the Board of Fire Commissioners meeting. Persons may not allocate unused time to other speakers.

Forum Restrictions and Orderly Conduct of Business. The Board of Fire Commissioners conducts the

business of the District and its citizens during its meetings. The presiding officer may order the removal of any person whose statement or other conduct disrupts the orderly, efficient or safe conduct of the meeting. Warnings against disruptive comments or behavior may or may not be given prior to removal. The viewpoint of a speaker will not be restricted, but reasonable restrictions may be imposed upon the time, place and manner of speech. Irrelevant and unduly repetitious statements and personal attacks which antagonize or incite others are examples of speech that may be reasonably limited.

Responses to Public Comments. The Board of Fire Commissioners can deliberate or take action only if a matter has been listed on an agenda properly posted prior to the meeting. The Open Meeting Law does not expressly prohibit responses to public comments by the Commission. However, responses from Fire Commissioners to unlisted public comment topics could become deliberation on a matter without notice to the public. To avoid this situation and to ensure that the public has notice of all matters the Board of Fire Commissioners will consider, Fire Commissioners may choose not to respond to public comments, except to correct factual inaccuracies, ask for District staff action or to ask that a matter be listed on a future agenda. The Fire Commissioners may do this either during the public comment item or during the item entitled "Commissioners'/Fire Chief's announcements, requests for information, or topics for future agendas."

Continuation of the public hearing from May 26, 2026, for further discussion of the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District Tentative Budget and possible adoption of the Final Budget for fiscal year 2026-2027 (FY26/27) with incorporated changes to the final budget directed by the Board at the May 26, 2026, public hearing. Estimated FY26/27 general fund revenues are \$59,571,662, and estimated general fund expenditures are (\$56,384,400). The proposed budget also includes expenditures/expenses from the following 8 other funds: Capital Projects Fund (\$3,204,000); Extraordinary Repairs & Maintenance Fund (\$176,000); Emergency Fund (\$1,500,000); Sick, Annual, and Comp Benefits Fund (\$1,310,000); Stabilization Fund (\$550,000); Debt Service Fund (\$1,317,653); Worker's Comp Internal Service/Proprietary Fund (\$507,500); and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Enterprise/Proprietary Fund (\$6,058,839). If approved, the Board shall certify the final budget for transmission to the Nevada Tax Commission (All Commission Districts).
